Abide 101

The Heart of Abiding

“God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.”

(1 John 1:5, LSB)

God loves humanity and created us for fellowship with Him. Because God's character is perfectly unified, the Book that comes from His breath shares that unity. There is no inconsistency or self-contradiction in Him.

Meditate & Obey. Study & Apply. Hear & Do. This is how we abide in Christ.

When the Ground Shifts

Have you ever read two passages that seem to pull in opposite directions? This is not a sign that your faith is weak or that the Bible is broken.

When we find an apparent contradiction, it is not an obstacle. It is an invitation to dig deeper until the harmony reveals itself.

One Author. One Story.

The Harmony Guardrail

Any interpretation of a Bible passage must agree with the rest of the Bible.

While Scripture has many human writers, it has exactly one Divine Author.

Every verse belongs to one story, moving toward one destination.

“Whoever then annuls one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven...”

(Matthew 5:19, LSB)

Principle: Scripture interprets Scripture.

The Diagnostic Filter

Filter 1: Who is writing, and to whom?

Understanding the author's situation and the readers' unique needs often reveals passages are answering different questions, not fighting each other.

Filter 2: What genre am I reading?

A psalm expresses differently than a law code. A letter communicates differently than a prophecy. Honoring genre prevents false contradictions.

Practice Case 1: Faith and Works

For by grace you have been saved through faith... not of works, so that no one may boast.
(Ephesians 2:8–9, LSB)



You see that a man is justified by works and not by faith alone.
(James 2:24, LSB)

At first glance, this is a head-on collision. Which one is correct?
The Harmony Guardrail tells us: Both are.

Completing, Not Contradicting

	Paul (<i>Ephesians</i>)	James (<i>James</i>)
The Audience's Error	Trying to earn God's acceptance through effort.	Claiming faith but showing no life change.
The Question Answered	How are we saved?	How do we prove faith is genuine?
Meaning of Justification	Legal declaration before God.	Visible evidence before others.

We are saved by grace through faith alone, but the faith that saves us is never alone. It always works.

Practice Case 2: The Sign That Waited

8th Century BC



“Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call call His name Immanuel.”

(Isaiah 7:14, LSB)

Read in isolation, this is only a piece of the picture. The prophecy is waiting. We cannot yet tell who the virgin is, or when this will happen.

The Bible Explains Itself

8th Century BC

Roughly 700 years later, Matthew connects the events of Jesus' birth directly to Isaiah's promise.
(Matthew 1:22–23, LSB)



1st Century

- The virgin is Mary. The son is Jesus.
- Immanuel means God with us.

Scripture interprets Scripture. The Old Testament gives the promise; the New Testament shows its fulfillment.

Where the Guardrails Converge

The Harmony Guardrail is the seventh and final tool in Abide 101.
It brings all the others to their proper conclusion.

Practice, Not Performance

*The things you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.
(Philippians 4:9, LSB)*

Bible engagement is a rhythm to be maintained, not an achievement to be mastered. You do not need to be a scholar. Bring your tools, show up with faith, and practice. The God of peace will meet you there.

Unite My Heart

*Teach me Your way, O Yahweh;
I will walk in Your truth;
Unite my heart to fear Your name.
(Psalm 86:11, LSB)*



A divided heart looks for confirmation of what it already believes. A united heart comes ready to hear what God actually said. The Harmony Guardrail gives us access to the full, beautiful picture of who God is.
